India has the 2nd highest mortality rate among the SAARC countries with 48 deaths per thousand births. While a large number of children develop some kind of chronic disease in their initial years, not every child gets the privilege to be treated on time due to their financially weak background and hence they fail to survive, causing great loss to their families and to the society.

Aayush is an initiative by Diya India Foundation exclusively serving children up to 14 years of age with diseases like congenital heart disease, hearing disabilities, cancer, brain malformations etc. that require immediate attention and costly treatment. With bearing the cost of treatment and providing efficient medical facilities, we have successfully saved the lives of 553 children and given new hopes and immense happiness to their families. In this Initiative the Foundation is giving awareness sessions and distributing sanitary pads to the underprivileged women free of cost every month so that there is no risk to their health and also helping women to embrace their womanhood in a healthy way.

It also aims at 'breaking the ceiling' of the old Menstruation taboos prevailing in our society today through knowledge awareness, thus, changing the mind-set of the people positively.

- Today, girls do not have consistent access to sanitary pads. In India, almost 88% of women use homemade alternatives, such as an old cloth, rags, sand or ash which are unhygienic and causes a lot of health problems to them.
- Due to lack of awareness, there are a lot of taboos associated with menstruation because of which women consider them impure and observe various religious and social restrictions. So to overcome such social challenges, hence #ProudtoBleed!!

It isn't easy for parents to anticipate in hope that someday their child would hear them. With the “**You support, We connect**” campaign, Diya India Foundation has taken the initiative to help underprivileged children who are suffering from partial or complete hearing loss by providing them with hearing aids and hearing implants at Asha Speech and Hearing Clinic in Delhi.

In India, 63 million people (6.3%) suffer from the significant auditory loss. Four in every 1000 children suffer from severe to profound hearing loss. With over 100,000 babies that are born with hearing deficiency every year.

A person suffering from hearing impairment has difficulty in perceiving or identifying sound clearly due to auditory problems. The impairment may be unilateral or bilateral.

It was observed that in case of hearing-impaired children, by the time parents fully understood the nature of the problem and took steps to overcome it, it became too late for a child to acquire language and speech. A child who is denied timely help gets into his/her own shell and gets totally cut off from society.

If a child who is suffering from such condition is given aid under the age of 5 years, the chance for him or her to learn to speak and understand is better than if the procedure is done at a later age.

Millions of people lack mobility, and without wheelchairs or sticks, their options are limited. There are thousands of people who, without wheelchair are crawling on the floor and wherever their families go they have to take them in their arms.

1. An application in Form No. 10A seeking Registration u/s 12AA was filed on 12/07/2018.

2. The Trust / Society / Non profit company was constituted by deed of trust/memorandum of association / instrument dated 29/06/2014.

3. After considering the material available on record, this applicant trust / society / company is granted registration as - General Public Utility. Trust / Society / Company and the provisions of Sections 11 and 12 shall apply in the case from A.Y. 2015-16. The trust/society/SPO is registered at S. No. DEL - DR24180 - 20012019 of the register maintained in this office. The registration is granted subject to the following conditions:

Conditions:

(i) Order u/s 12AA(1)(b) read with section 12A does not confer any right of exemption upon the applicant u/s 11, 12 and 13 of the Income Tax Act, 1961. (iv) The trust/institution shall furnish a return of income every year within the time limit prescribed under the act.

(v) The trust/institution shall quote the PAN in all its communications with the Department.

(vi) The registration u/s 12AA of the I.T. Act, 1961 does not automatically confer any right on the donors to claim deduction/s 80G.

(vii) This certificate cannot be used as a basis for claiming non-deduction of tax at source in respect of investments etc. relating to the Trust/institution.

(viii) All the Public Money to be received including for Corpus or any contribution shall be credited through a Bank Account and each Bank Account Number shall be communicated to this office.

(ix) No change in the terms of Deed of the Trust shall be effected without due procedure of law i.e. by order of the jurisdictional High Court and its intimation shall be given immediately to this office. The registering authority reserves the right to consider whether any such alteration in objects would be consistent with the definition of "charitable purposes" under the Act and in conformity with the requirement of continuity of objectives.

(x) No asset shall be transferred without the knowledge of the undersigned to anyone, including to any Trust / Society / Non profit Company etc.

(xi) The registered office or the principal place of activity of the applicant should not be transferred outside the national capital territory, Delhi except with the prior approval of the CIT(E), Delhi.

(xii) If later on it is found that the registration has been obtained fraudulently by misrepresentation or suppression of any fact, the Registration so granted is liable to be cancelled as per provisions u/s section 12AA(2) of the Act.

(xiii) The registration so granted is liable to be cancelled at any point of time, if the registering authority is satisfied that activities of the trust/institution are no genuine or are not being carried out in accordance with the objects of the Trust/institution.
