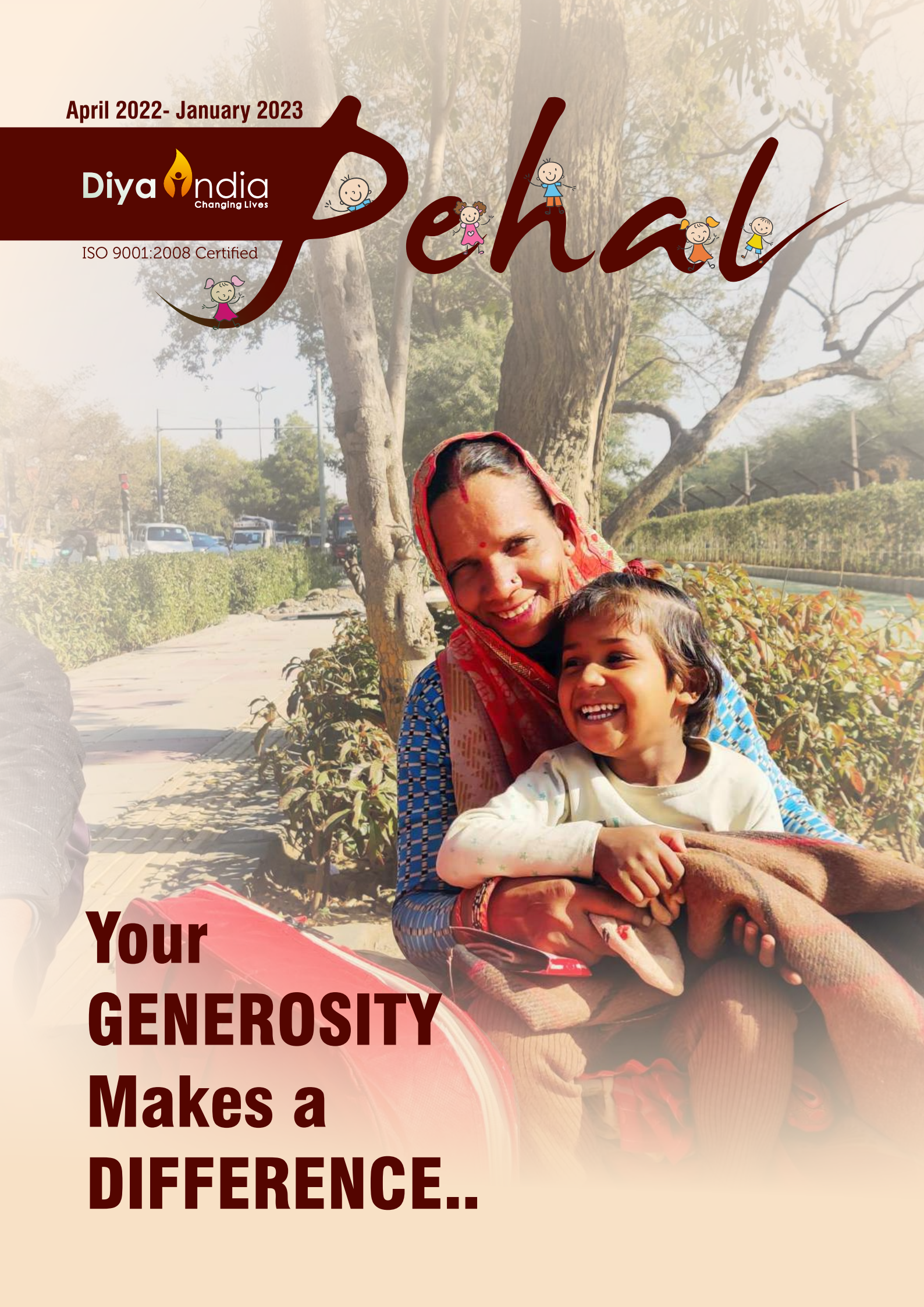

- › To promote a healthy society by encouraging environment sustainable measures like tree plantations & cleanliness drives across the country.

You are not just the Supporter you are "Earth Angels". Alone we can do so little but together we can do so much.

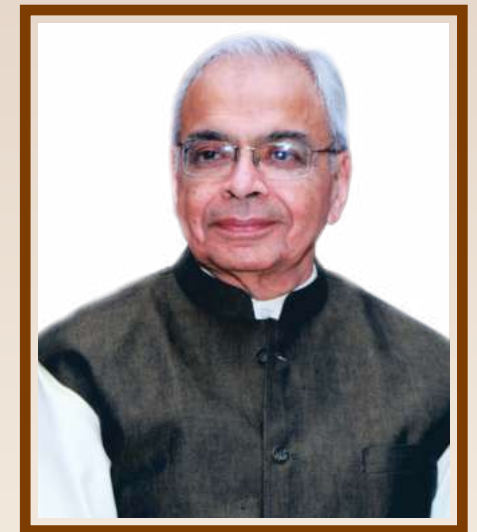
As Diya India is determined with bigger goals now, your continued patronage will not only be a catalyst in our journey but will also be a big support in bringing significant change in the society.

WAR AGAINST HUNGER

Every month more than 200 BPL families which cannot afford two square meals a day are benefitted with free food supplies in the slums of Madipur, Nihal Vihar, Delhi under our initiative "WAR AGAINST HUNGER". Diya India sincerely impresses upon the idea that no one should go to bed hungry and suffer consequences due to hunger. Foundation is taking relevant steps to combat hunger.



AAYUSH

"Children are one third of our population and our future"

Every year more than 2 lakh children are born with Congenital Heart Disease in India who seeks immediate medical attention. Due to lack of financial stability many underprivileged parents are not able to afford the expenses of treatments and surgeries.

Under our initiative AAYUSH, Diya India aims to provide medical aid to the underprivileged children upto the age of 14 years suffering from Congenital Heart Disease, Brain Diseases and Hearing Impairment with costly medical treatments thereby giving them the "GIFT OF LIFE".

In last months we have saved the lives of 21 young souls and they are now living happy and healthy life in their respective homes.



IF YOU DID IT !!

Abdullah(10 years) is a special child. He is suffering from cerebral palsy. Cerebral palsy (CP) is a group of disorders that affect a person's ability to move and maintain balance and posture. Abdullah experience the world in a different way than others of his age. When we got the case he was not able to speak properly, walk, eat or even manage his daily day to day activities. Today with support from our Generous Supporters through regular physiotherapy he is recovering fast. He has started gaining speech, walking without falling down and eating on his own. He wish to lead a life like the children of his age.



#MISSION CARE

In our new initiative #Mission Care we aim at supporting hospitals with medical devices free of cost. We have identified hospital working for the underprivileged section of the society. Team of Diya India recently distributed medical devices like oxymeters, thermometers, sanitisers, gloves, wheelchairs, walking sticks to SGS Multispeciality Hospital in Nihal Vihar. #Mission Care is not just an initiative but a life changing experience for the underprivileged communities. The Foundation vision is "Medical services should be accessible to all".



HOPE

Under initiative "Project Hope" Diya India focuses on livelihood development of the marginalised people, improving their quality of living. Recently we were able to provide roof and ration to 80 homeless families living on streets.

Their huts were shattered due to heavy storm and winds. Their children were forced to sleep on rags. They were struggling for one-time meal in a day. With the kind support from our supporters team of Diya India distributed tarpaulin, ration and slippers and brought smiles on their faces.





GURUKUL

Diya India Foundation believes that education is the basic necessity for every child after food, clothes and shelter. Every child should get equal opportunities to attend school, learn and prosper in life. Sadly, the status quo of education in India is poor with over 8.4 crore children not getting even a basic education due to critical factors like poverty.

Gurukul is an initiative by Diya India Foundation to support education of children whose parents cannot afford their schooling. With good teachers, infrastructure, books, and stationery, we ensure that there is no compromise on the quality. The goal is to ensure that monetary hindrance should not restrict them to grow up into successful and responsible adults.

The Foundation is currently supporting two schools Chetan Vidya Mandir and Chetan Playway running at Nihal Vihar, a slum area in Delhi



Gift Of Warmth

During the freezing winter nights of Delhi, when the entire city dons their blankets, Monkey -Caps and mufflers with a hot cup of tea, there are many underprivileged who cannot even afford a sweater and are left alone to shiver.

To give them warmth, Diya India Foundation distributed more than 350 Blankets, Warmers, Woolen Caps and Woolen Socks to the elderly and under privileged people living on the streets and in the slums of Nangloi and Peeragarhi, shivering from the cold. The happiness on their face cannot be defined in words after receiving this Gift of Warmth. Diya India Foundation is happy to witness the overwhelming response. We are thankful to our Supporters for helping us in this noble cause.



PROUD TO BLEED



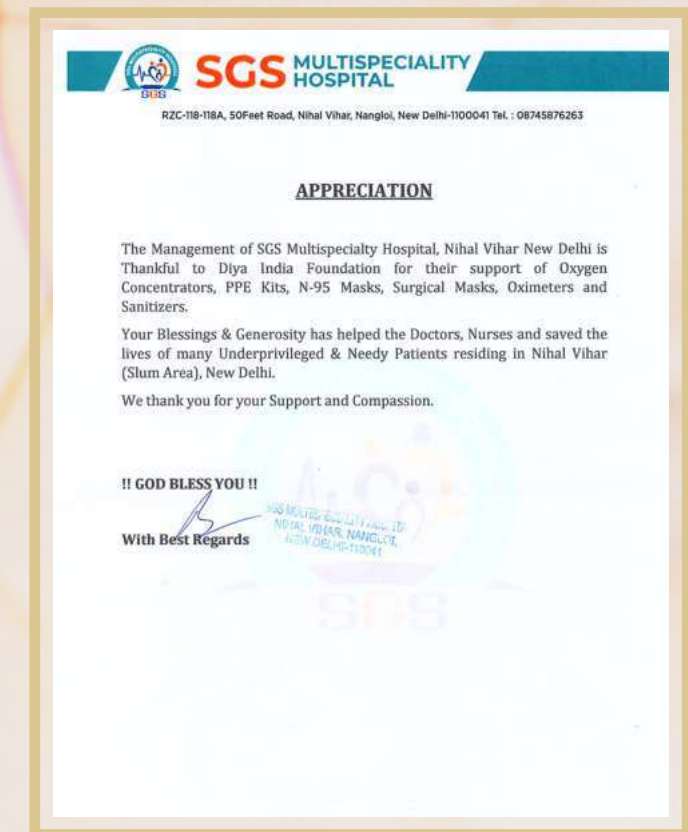
Diya India started initiative "PROUD TO BLEED" with an aim to break taboos about menstruation in India. Out of 60.47 crores women in India only 36 percent use sanitary napkins. These numbers are shocking. Team of Diya India conducts awareness sessions in the slums of Delhi creating awareness about the same. Foundation ensures that sanitary napkins should be available to every woman even in the remote areas by distributing free of cost napkins.

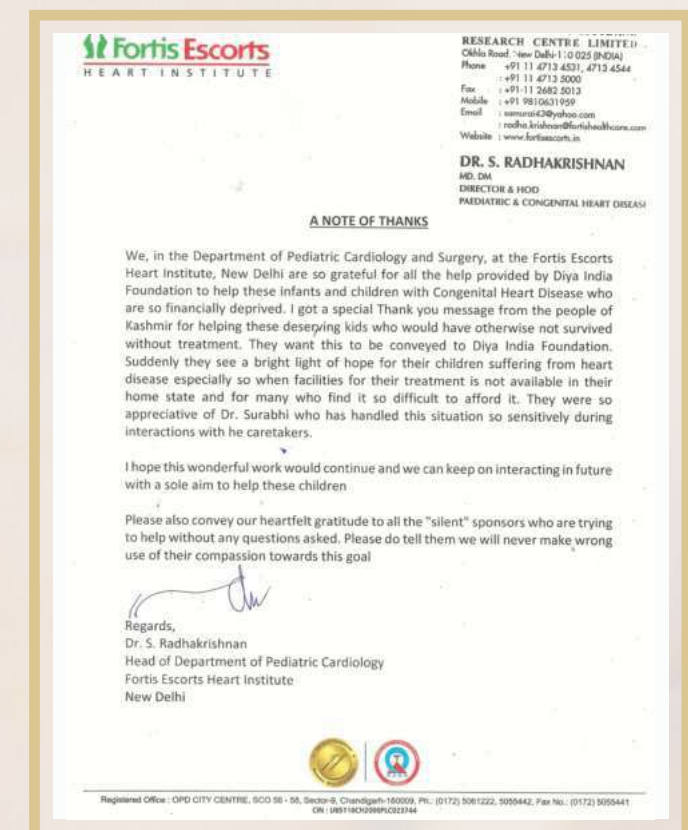
