As Diya India is determined with bigger goals now, your continued patronage will not only be a catalyst in our journey but will also be a big support in bringing significant change in the society.

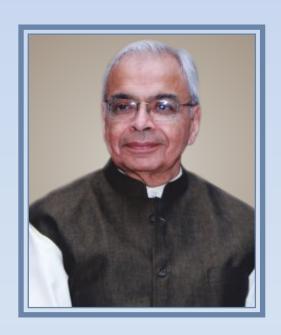
In this edition, you will be glad and feel proud to see how your gifts have brought positive changes in the life of many.

War Against Hunger

This program ensures that poor families do not sleep hungry every night and their children do not become stunted, a common problem among the poverty stricken children.
