Let us continue this journey of Saving Lives, Nurturing Dreams, and Spreading Smiles.

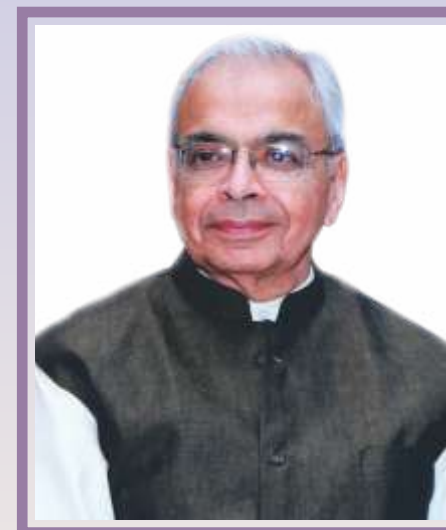

While bearing the cost of treatment and providing efficient medical facilities with the help of our supporters, we have been able to successfully save the lives of more than 25 children from January 2025 to August 2025 which has given new hopes and immense happiness to their families. New cases are coming to us constantly and we are glad to provide relief to them with a mission to let more number of **Little Hearts Beat**

War Against Hunger

Food is an everyday problem for underprivileged community who, despite working diligently, could not provide sufficient food to their families.

Diya India Foundation feels proud to be the torchbearer of a very noble cause "War against Hunger", is an initiative that is driven towards fighting hunger by offering free monthly ration to the underprivileged families.

The Foundation is supporting 200 families who are given necessary dry rations every month. Our dry ration kit includes rice, oil, pulses, wheat flour, sugar and salt.


Apart from monthly distribution, the Foundation is also distributing freshly cooked meals to more than 1500 underprivileged people every month.





The idea behind this initiative is to provide sanitary pads not only affordable but also available in remote areas of Delhi and NCR.

With the help of our support team we have distributed 700 sanitary napkins to the underprivileged Female workers of Shahi Exports Pvt. Ltd. and educated them on menstrual health and hygiene.

Gift of Mobility

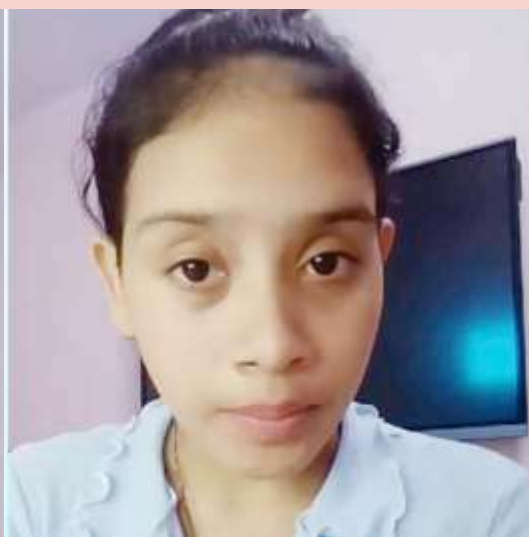

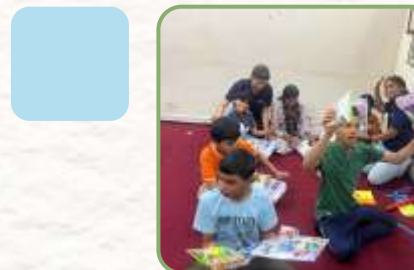
