We Welcome you to Diya India Foundation's Newsletter containing our activities distribution and future endeavors.


We truly believe that with the help of our supporter such as you, we will make a difference in the lives of Underprivileged section of the society.

As Diya India is determined with bigger goals now, your continued patronage will not only be a catalyst in our journey but will also be a big support in bringing significant change in the society.

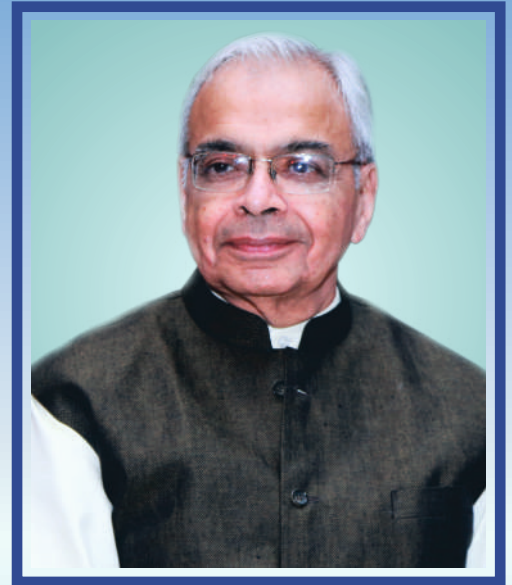

AAYUSH is an endeavour by Diya India Foundation serving children up to 14 years of age with congenital heart diseases, congenital malformation, hearing disabilities that require immediate attention and costly treatment. While bearing the cost of treatment and providing efficient medical facilities with the help of our supporters, we have successfully saved more than 14 children in six months which has given new hopes and immense happiness to their families. ## Gift of Mobility

Millions of people lack mobility, and without wheelchairs or sticks, their options are limited. There are thousands of people who, without wheelchair are crawling on the floor and wherever their families go they have to take them in their arms.

Diya India under its initiative Giving Gift of Mobility to bring light in the lives of specially abled underprivileged people, Diya India distributed 20 Walking Sticks and 10 Wheelchairs to them.

This Gift of Mobility has given unbelievable joy to the recipients and their families.

Many kids nowadays have forgotten their parent's hardships and love for them, considering them as liabilities rather than an asset. And hence, they send them away to live in old age home.

Geeta Mandir old age home is one such place that provides a loving home for the elderly. Volunteers from Diya India Foundation regularly visit them, and share moments of happiness and love. As a token of warmth in our relationship, we distributed blankets, woolen socks during winters to them. Their eyes filled with tears of happiness.

Diya India also distributes ration, vegetables, bed sheets, daily need items on monthly basis to them. Every visit is an interactive session where the golden agers pour their hearts out to us. Their blessings and unwavering hopes always motivates us to keep up the good work.



## Proud to Bleed

The idea behind this initiative is to break the taboo about menstruation in India and make sanitary pads not only affordable but also available to every woman & girl even in the remote areas of Delhi and NCR.

In last six month with the help of our support team we have distributed 14000 sanitary napkins to the underprivileged women and girls residing in the slum area of Vasant Vihar, New Delhi, Nihal Vihar and Madipur, West Delhi.

As a part of our monthly ration distribution for the low socio-economic and daily wage workers affected by Covid-19 the foundation fulfilled its promise of regular distribution of dry ration to 200 families and meals to 6000 people.
