

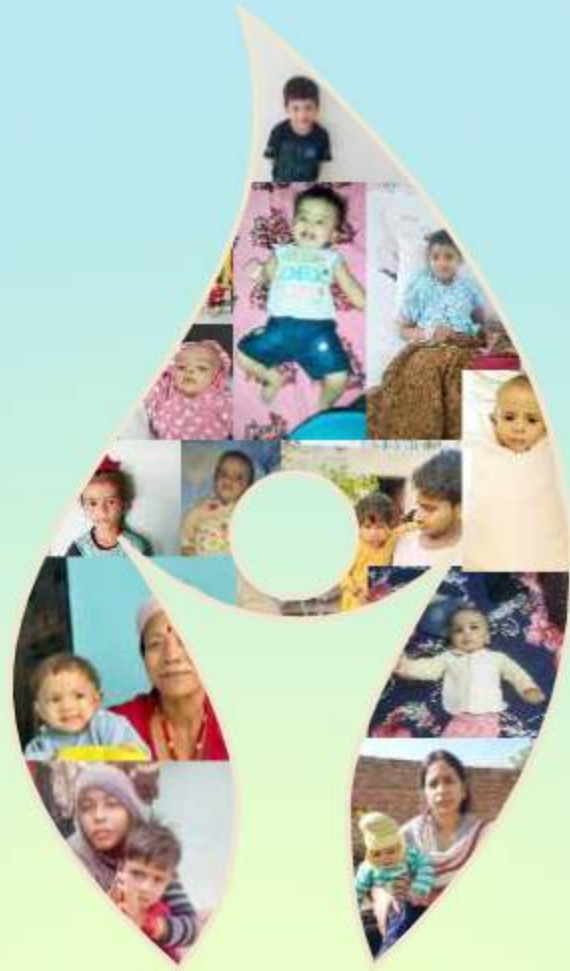

Aayush is an initiative by Diya India which aims at giving the young souls another chance at life. The underprivileged children as young as newborn babies to the age of 14 who are suffering from Congenital Heart Disease, Brain Disease and Hearing impairment are provided with appropriate medical treatment. The idea behind is to provide advanced healthcare facilities to the children whose parents are in no capacity to afford their treatment. The foundation has provided their families with financial and emotional support. These children come from economically weaker sections of the society and their parents are either seasonally employed or are working at low wages. The initiative has brought a ray of hope in the lives of those who were hopeless after being dejected due to lack of funds for the treatment of their child.

Moreover, "You support, we connect" is a campaign under Aayush which supports underprivileged children who are suffering from partial or complete hearing loss have been provided with hearing aids. We have successfully benefitted 15 underprivileged children with hearing aids and speech therapy at Asha Speech and Hearing Clinic in Delhi. These children are now happy to hear and speak well. A child who is denied timely help gets into his/her own shell and gets totally cut off from society.

Congenital Heart Disease are treated with either open heart surgery or telescopic procedures at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, New Delhi, Fortis Escorts, New Delhi, Kingsway Hospital, Nagpur, Paras Hospital, New Delhi and Brain Diseases is treated at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital. More than 605 children have been bestowed with appropriate medical treatment during the last 9 years and we plan to increase this number rapidly in the future. 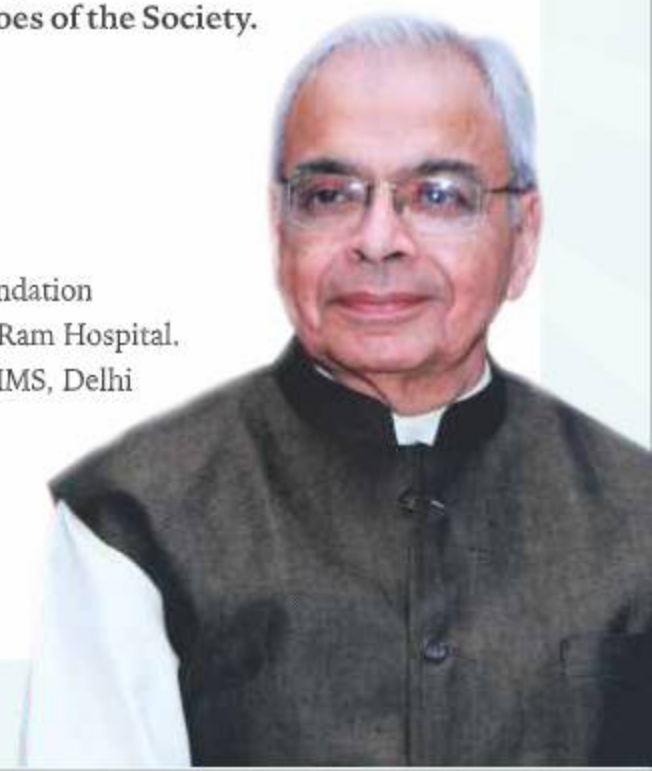

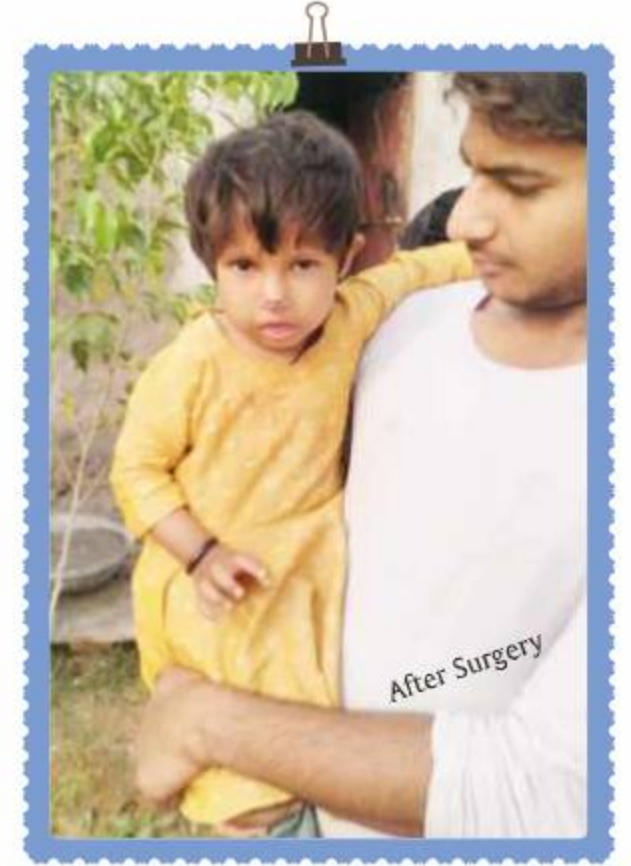

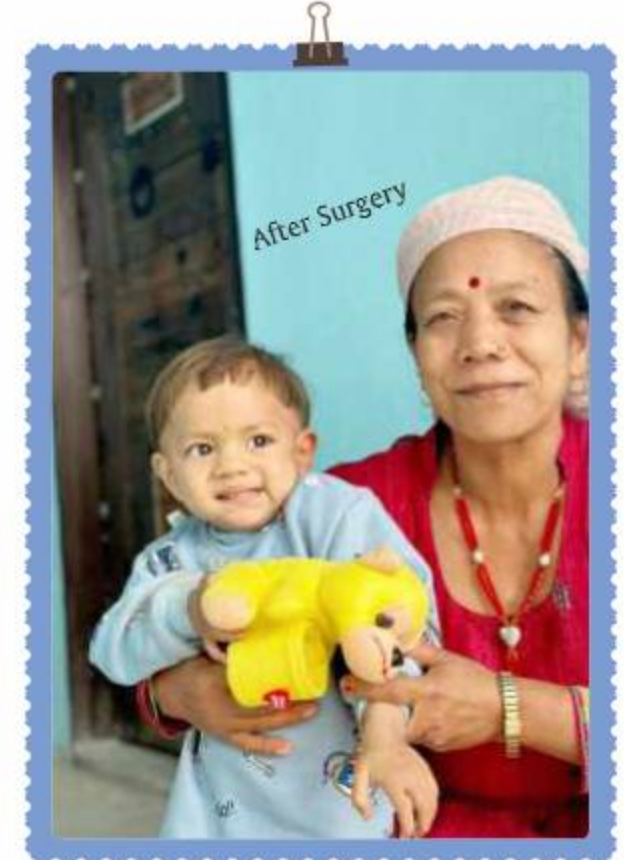
