### DIAGNOSIS

COARCTATION OF AORTA  
 S/P/RE BALLOON COARCTOPLASTY

### CLINICAL HISTORY

#### History:

6month old male child is a k/c/o coarctation of aorta .Balloon dilatation of COA was done on 2 months of life. Folowup ECHO showed features of recoarctation of aorta and child was taken up for balloon dilatation.

### PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

#### General Examination:

Child was conscious. oriented, afebrile.

No pallor, icterus, clubbing, cyanosis, lymphadenopathy or oedema. lower limb pulses both sides feeble.

#### Systemic examination:

RS - Chest clear bilaterally. Air entry equal. No crepitations or wheeze.

CVS - Heart sounds normal. No murmur heard.

P/A -Abdomen is soft, not tender and not distended. No hepatosplenomegaly. Bowel sounds are normal.

CNS - Child was conscious and oriented. Muscle tone and reflexes are normal. Plantars are down-going. No signs of meningeal irritation. Pupils are normal sized and normally reactive to light bilaterally

### CLINICAL SUMMARY

After relevant pre-procedure workup .patient was taken up for balloon dilatation.Patient tolerated the procedure well and was shifted to PCS ICU post procedure.Patient remained hemodynamically stable throughout stay and was on room air. At the time of discharge, child is hemodynamically stable, on room air, accepting oral feed and passing adequate urine.

### DISCHARGE ADVICE

- 1- Tab ASA 50MG 1/2 TAB PO ONCE DAILY AT 2pm after food
- 2- Tab LANZOL JUNIOR 15MG 1/2 tab OD AT 7 AM
- 3- Tab ENVAS 2.5MG 1/4 Tab PO TWICE DAILY (8am,8 pm)
- 4- SUNSIP drops 1ml PO once daily
